

**Fee schedule according to the German International Health Regulations Implementing Act Attachment 2  
(in conjunction with § 18 section 6 and § 19 section 7)**

Please note: *Only the German version is authoritative. The English version is for information purposes only.*

1. If sanitary conditions are to be inspected on board, the following fee for individually attributable public services according to § 18 section 1 to 5 (Free Pratique) shall be payable: **75 EUR.**
2. The following fee for individually attributable public services according to § 19 section 5 sentence 1 no. 1 (Ship sanitation control exemption certificate) shall be payable:
  - a) on ships that transport more than 12 people commercially or are licensed to do so and deployed for this purpose (passenger ships)
    - aa) up to a registered tonnage of 2000 **245 EUR,**
    - bb) for a reg. tonnage of 2001 to 10000 **490 EUR,**
    - cc) for a reg. tonnage greater than 10000 **670 EUR,**
  - b) on inland navigation vessels **120 EUR,**
  - c) on all other vessel types
    - aa) up to a registered tonnage of 1000 **120 EUR,**
    - bb) for a reg. tonnage of 1001 to 2000 **180 EUR,**
    - cc) for a reg. tonnage of 2001 to 35000 **245 EUR,**
    - dd) for a reg. tonnage of 35001 to 85000 **305 EUR,**
    - ee) for a reg. tonnage greater than 85000 **400 EUR.**
3. The following fees apply for individually attributable public services according to § 19 section 5 sent. 1 no. 2 (ship sanitation control certificate) in addition to the charges according to no. 2:
  - a) on passenger ships
    - aa) up to a registered tonnage of 2000 **90 EUR,**
    - bb) for a reg. tonnage of 2001 to 10000 **155 EUR,**
    - cc) for a reg. tonnage greater than 10000 **230 EUR,**
  - b) on inland navigation vessels **45 EUR,**
  - c) on all other vessel types
    - aa) up to a registered tonnage of 2000 **45 EUR,**
    - bb) for a reg. tonnage of 2001 to 35000 **75 EUR,**
    - cc) for a reg. tonnage of 35001 to 85000 **105 EUR,**
    - dd) for a reg. tonnage greater than 85000 **135 EUR.**
4. The following surcharge for individually attributable public services according to § 19 section 5 sentence 1 no. 1 or no. 2 that are performed Mondays to Fridays between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m., on weekends, or on a public holiday, shall be payable:
  - a) on passenger ships
    - aa) up to a registered tonnage of 2000 **105 EUR,**
    - bb) for a reg. tonnage of 2001 to 10000 **210 EUR,**
    - cc) for a reg. tonnage greater than 10000 **290 EUR,**
  - b) on inland navigation vessels **55 EUR,**
  - c) on all other vessel types
    - aa) up to a registered tonnage of 1000 **55 EUR,**
    - bb) for a reg. tonnage of 1001 to 2000 **80 EUR,**
    - cc) for a reg. tonnage of 2001 to 35000 **110 EUR,**
    - dd) for a reg. tonnage of 35001 to 85000 **135 EUR,**
    - ee) for a reg. tonnage greater than 85000 **175 EUR.**
5. The fees increase by a commuting allowance for drives longer than 15 km per every half hour: **25 EUR.**
6. The following fee for the extension of a ship sanitation control exemption certificate according to § 19 section 5 sent. 1 no. 3 shall be payable:
  - a) in cases of § 19 section 5 sent. 1 no. 3 letter a **70 EUR,**
  - b) in cases of § 19 section 5 sent. 1 no. 3 letter b half of the amount of no. 2.
7. In cases where the ship inspection is delayed after the arrival of the authorized inspector or port health official for reasons for which the debtor is responsible, in particular if he or she does not meet his or her obligations according to §19 section 4 sent. 2, an additional fee is charged for every half hour of delay: **40 EUR.**
8. For additional expenditure because of necessary reviews, because of medical assessments, or because of the implementation or execution of other measures the fee increases for every commenced half hour: **40 EUR.**
9. The following fee for an additional copy of certificates according to § 19 section 5 sent. 1 no.1 and 2 shall be payable: **35 EUR.**
