The Winter Emergency Programme is a state offer and is aimed exclusively at homeless people who are looking for overnight accommodation free of charge and anonymously if they wish and **who have no other options for overnight accommodation or other form of self-help.**

A <u>free bus shuttle from Fördern & Wohnen</u> will run from Friesenstraße to Halskestraße in the evening. Those who stay there overnight can use a bus transfer to the city centre in the morning. Information concerning this is available at Friesenstraße.

Warming rooms

Consultation services

The Winter Emergency Program offers free social counselling. This will help you find a way out of homelessness. Talk to the social workers at Fördern & Wohnen and let them help you.

In order to get a spot at a residential accommodation, you must first have your entitlement to social benefits checked at the Jobcenter team.arbeit.hamburg (Kleine Reichenstraße 2, 20457 Hamburg).

Note: A personal visit is possible only by prior appointment.
