the history of beer gardens:

- origins date back as far as 1539
- beer brewing was allowed only between September 29th and April 23rd, as it was too dangerous in summer
- so people needed to store beer for the summer
- to keep the beer cool and fresh, brewers dug cellars and planted chestnut trees on top
- these places attracted many day-trippers, so clever brewers started selling their beer at the places where they stored it, which led to complaints by innkeepers
- January 4th 1812: King Max I. Joseph of Bavaria legalized those "beer gardens"
- as he prohibited the sale of food, patrons had to bring their own

what is so special about beer gardens in Munich:

- even today people are allowed to take their food to beer gardens and do so, something that would not be tolerated in any other sort of restaurant
- the only things patrons have to buy in the beer garden are their beverages
- this has been a tradition for 200 years now
